किताबें पढ़ने का महत्व

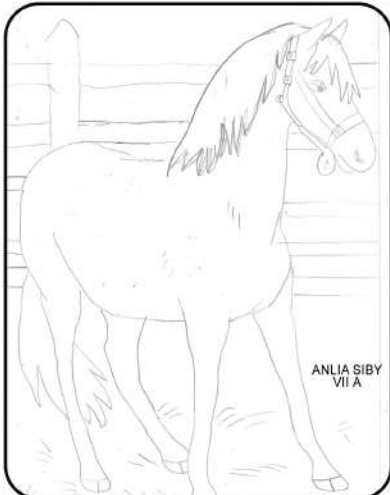

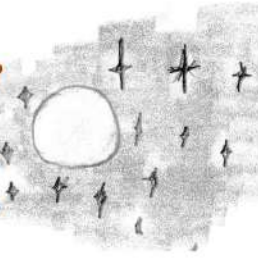
